## EVENTS

**Weapon Classes for Individual Events: (see definitions in General Rules)**

**Revolver Police Sports and Revolver Police Duty Classes**  
**Semi-Automatic Police Sports and Semi Automatic Police Duty Classes**

**NOTE:** Competitors must shoot the Individual event to be eligible to shoot the Distinguished Match.  
Competitors may shoot only one class of gun; either Revolver or Semi-automatic.  
Competitors may shoot only one category of gun: either Sport or Duty

## **INDIVIDUAL**

Revolver and Semi Automatic Police SPORTS and Police DUTY:

Male: Open and Grand Master (50+)

Female: Open and Grand Master (50+)

**TEAM: 4 persons, UNISEX, POLICE SPORTS and POLICE DUTY, revolver and Semi Auto classes**

The Team event score is the total of the Individual event scores of the team members who shoot Match #5 (National Police Course); 60 shots. Each team member can shoot a total of **600 points** for a possible team score of **2,400 points**.

## **WPFG ABRIDGED RULES-PISTOL–POLICE PISTOL COMBAT (PPC)–Pg 2**

### EQUIPMENT

Targets: NRA approved targets only, see NRA Rule 4. The target normally used for this event is a B-27 Target.

### SCHEDULING

The Police Pistol Combat (PPC) event should be held Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; or Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

### GENERAL SPORT RULES for Pistol - PPC

Current NRA Guide Lines shall apply to this sport, with the exception of the awards formula, classifications and the eligibility of competitors. WPFG Rules and regulations will govern these areas. Where there is a conflict between NRA rules and WPFG Rules always use WPFG Rules.

**No 2-Person Teams.** Only 4-person Teams allowed.

**CLASSIFICATION:** Only WPFG Classifications will be used.

### WEAPONS, AMMUNITION AND HOLSTERS

#### **Weapons Police Sports:**

- A. Be Revolvers or Semi-Automatic pistols with a caliber minimum .38 sp/9mm
- B. The trigger pull must be 3 pounds minimum for first shot
- C. The barrel is maximum 6 inches
- D. Only rear sights can be adjustable

#### **Weapons Police Duty:**

- A. Be semi-automatic for pistols; revolvers trigger must have a single and double action capability
- B. Can be single action, double action, double action only, or safe action (when the trigger is pulled, the hammer/striker is cocked and then released).
- C. Be 9mm (9x19) .38 special or larger caliber.
- D. Fit in the IDPA gun test box measuring 8 ¾" x 6" x 1 5/8" with an empty magazine inserted.
- E. The weapon has only FIXED SIGHTS (or sights blocked during the competition)

**NO MODIFIED WEAPONS CAN BE USED IN THIS EVENT.**

#### **Ammunition:**

\* NOTE: REVOLVERS AND SEMI-AUTOMATICS MAY USE FACTORY OR RELOADED AMMO, WITH EITHER ROUND NOSE LEAD, SEMI-WADCUTTER, JACKETED HOLLOW POINTS OR JACKETED SOFT-POINT

BULLETS, NO WAD-CUTTERS OR MID-RANGE (REDUCED ENERGY) AMMO CAN BE USED. RELOADED AMMUNITION SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FACTORY AMMUNITION.

**Ammunition Carriers:** All Ammo Carriers must hold the magazine with enough tension to allow it to be turned upside down and retain a fully loaded magazine. Carriers may have a snap or have a Velcro closure, and be part of the “Sam Brown” gear, or, attached to the belt on a belt loop holster.

**Ammunition:** for Revolvers will be new issue factory produced, but must be at least 158 grain, lead, round nose, semi-wadcutter or hollow point loads. No wadcutters, +P, no reloads, no mid-range or magnum loads. Ammunition for Semi-automatics will be new issue factory produced, jacketed ball, semi-jacketed hollow point or jacketed soft-point loads. No wadcutters, +P, no reloads, magnum or mid-range (reduced energy) loads.

**Holsters:** This competition is designed for use of duty weapons relating to Police work. Holsters must also comply with NRA Rule 3.12. No tie-down rigs (SWAT gear) or similar type gear, and holsters will be at hip level.

### **COURSE OF FIRE; NRA POLICE PISTOL COMBAT MATCH AND NATIONAL POLICE COURSE (See NRA Rule 7):**

**Match #1 - 7 Yards -** Standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 20 seconds

**Match #1 - 15 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 20 seconds

**Match #2 - 25 Yards-** Kneeling, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, right hand barricade, 6 shots, all double action within 90 seconds

**Match #3 - 50 Yards-** Sitting, 6 shots, prone, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, right hand barricade, 6 shots, all either single or double action and within 2 minutes and 45 seconds

**Match #4 - 25 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 35 seconds

**Match #4 - 25 Yards-** Repeat again, standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 35 seconds

**Total rounds shot in Matches #1 through #4 is 90 shots.**

**Match #5 - 7 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 20 seconds

**Match #5 - 25 Yards-** Kneeling, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, right hand barricade, 6 shots, all double action within 90 seconds

## WPGF ABRIDGED RULES-PISTOL-POLICE PISTOL COMBAT (PPC)-Pg 4

**Match #5 - 50 Yards-** Sitting, 6 shots, prone, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, either single or double action and all within 2 minutes and 45 seconds

**Match #5 - 25 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 6 shots within 12 seconds

**Total rounds shot in Match #5 is 60 Shots.**

**Total Course of Fire for Matches 1 through 5 is 150 rounds, for a total possible score of 1,500 points.**

### NRA POLICE DISTINGUISHED MATCH COURSE OF FIRE (Sports and Duty)

The Distinguished Police Match for the **DUTY** weapons category is the same Course of Fire as Match #5 of the National Police Course, but the shooting distances are modified.

**Match #5 - 7 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 12 shots within 20 seconds

**Match #5 - 15 Yards-** Kneeling, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, right hand barricade, 6 shots, all double action within 90 seconds

**Match #5 - 25 Yards-** Sitting, 6 shots, prone, 6 shots, standing behind barricade left hand, 6 shots, either single or double action and all within 2 minutes and 45 seconds

**Match #5 - 15 Yards-** Standing without support, double action, 6 shots within 12 seconds

**Total rounds shot in Match #5 is 60 Shots.**
