EVENTS:

INDIVIDUAL: UNISEX

16 Yard	"A","B" & "C" Division
24 Yard	"A","B" & "C" Division
Doubles	"A", "B" & "C" Division
All Events	"A", "B" & "C" Division

5 PERSON TEAM: UNISEX

16 Yard	"A" & "B" Division
24 Yard	"A" & "B" Division
Doubles	"A" & "B" Division

NOTE: Divisions are based on the combination (average) of the 5-team member's classifications. See "Classification" for details.

WPFG ABRIDGED RULES: TRAP - Page 2

EQUIPMENT:

Shotguns: 12 or 20 gauge only; provided by competitor

Ammunition: Meets ATA/ISSF standard and each competitor shall provide his/her own ammunition. The club/facility will have ammunition available for sale on-site. Reloaded ammunition is acceptable as long as it does not exceed ATA/ISSF specifications.

SCHEDULING:

This sport will take all day to run, usually from 0800 hours to 1830 hours, depending on the number of traps available and squads entered. Trap will be held on Thursday, following the Skeet or Monday prior to Skeet if Sporting Clays can't be held on Friday.

The 16 Yard event should start at 0800 hours. The 24 Yard event will follow (usually prior to the lunch break). After the 24 Yard event is concluded the Doubles event will start. At the conclusion of the Doubles event, all "shoot offs" ties will be held.

Squading of the teams and individuals will be done the day prior to the Trap competition (at Skeet) or with the WPFGF Director and the Sports Coordinator at the Bracketing Meeting.

When a team is minus a shooter at their scheduled time, the team will be moved to the end of the squading sheet. If, at this time the team is still missing a shooter, the team will be disqualified from the Team event and the shooters who are present will be eligible only for the Individual event.

All competitors will be on-site one hour prior to their scheduled time to help move the sport on in an orderly/timely fashion.

SCORING:

Individual: Individual scores of the 16 Yard, 24 Yard, and Doubles events

Team: The Team score is the total aggregate of the Individual scores of the 5-team members.

"All Events": The total aggregate score of the 16 Yard, 24 Yard and Doubles events. A competitor must compete in the 16 yd., 24 yd. and Doubles Individual events to be eligible for "All Events".

GENERAL SPORT RULES for Trap:

16 Yard Event: Each shooter attempts 100 clay birds
24 Yard Event: Each shooter attempts 100 clay birds
Doubles Event: Each shooter attempts 100 clay birds thrown 2 at a time (50 pairs)

CLASSIFICATION: The below listed classifications will determine in which division the competitor will compete. If a competitor has no established WPFG classification, he/she will be classified on the 100 targets in each of the Individual events entered. The high and low scores will be thrown out and the two remaining scores doubled. The doubled score will be the competitor's classification for the current WPFG. "All Events" Division will be determined by a competitor's score's in all 3 Individual events. If a competitor shoots in two out of three "A" Division events, his/her classification for "All Events" will be "A" Division. The same formula applies for "B" and "C" Division in All Events.

The WPFG will keep a current record of all competitors' averages that have shot in the WPFG for a period of 10 years (5 WPFG). If a competitor has competed in more than three WPFG, then the competitor's classification will be based on their last three (3) scores.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

16 Yard: "A" Division - (94 and above)
"B" Division - (93 to 88)
"C" Division - (87 and below)

24 Yard: "A" Division - (88 and above)
"B" Division - (87 to 80)
"C" Division - (79 and below)

Doubles: "A" Division - (89 and above)
"B" Division - (88 to 83)
"C" Division - (82 and below)

TEAM EVENTS:

16 Yard: "A" Division - Three (3) "A" Division competitors or more
"B" Division - Three (3) "B" or "C" Division competitors or more

24 Yard: "A" Division - Three (3) "A" Division competitors or more
"B" Division - Three (3) "B" or "C" Division competitors or more

Doubles: "A" Division - Three (3) "A" Division competitors or more
"B" Division - Three (3) "B" or "C" Division competitors or more

SHOOT-OFF RULES FOR TIES:

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

16 Yard:

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station, if tie is not broken, then;

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station at 24 Yards, if tie not broken, then;

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station at 25 Yards, if tie not broken, then;

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station at 27 Yards, until winner is determined.

24 Yard:

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station, if tie is not broken, then;

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station at 26 Yards, if tie not broken, then;

10 bird shoot off, two birds from each station at 27 Yards until winner is determined.

Doubles:

20 bird shoot off, two pair at each station at 16 Yards, until winner is determined.

TEAM EVENTS:

16 Yard:

Each team member in order will shoot 2 birds from each station for a total aggregate score of 50. If winner not decided, course will be repeated.

24 Yard:

Same as the 16 Yard Shoot-off, except at 24 Yards.

Doubles:

Each team member in order will shoot 2 pair of birds from each station for a total aggregate score of 100. If winner is not decided, course will be repeated.

ALL EVENTS:

Competitors will shoot 2 birds from each station at 16 and 24 Yards. For Doubles: 2 pair at each station. Total aggregate score of 40. If winner is not decided, course will be repeated.
