

# ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Every athlete must submit a separate Entry Form, listing each event entered. Complete all information including date of birth and contact information. DO NOT ABBREVIATE.

**Administrative Fee:** On-Line Entry at [www.cpaf.org](http://www.cpaf.org) or at [www.wspfg2010.org](http://www.wspfg2010.org) is strongly encouraged. A competitor who elects to enter using a paper Entry Form (whether mailed, faxed or submitted in person) will be charged a non-refundable Administrative Fee of \$10.00. This is in addition to any other fees, including Late Fees. **Note:** Team Captains who send team Entry Forms, Waivers, Sports Fees (one or more payments) and a complete Team Roster together in the same envelope will pay this fee one time.

**SUBMISSION GRAPPLING ENTRANTS:** must submit a medical release, signed by a licensed physician, verifying fitness to compete in a contact sport and based on a physical exam within the last 6 months.

**BOXING ENTRANTS:** Professionals will not be allowed to enter. All Boxers must submit a

Western States Police & Fire Games Federation "REPORT OF PHYSICAL EXAMINATION", signed by a licensed physician. This document must be current, based on a physical exam within the last 6 months and be received prior to or during Host Registration.

Each event has an 8 character Event Code; the last 3 digits represent the fees for the event. Select the appropriate Event Code(s) and enter in the correct boxes on the Entry Form – **see example below.**

IF ENTERING A TEAM OR DOUBLES EVENT, IT IS MANDATORY TO LIST THE LAST NAME AND FIRST NAME OF YOUR TEAM CAPTAIN OR DOUBLES PARTNER.

**POOLING:** If you wish to enter a Team or Doubles event, but do not have a partner: enter the event, pay the fees and check the Request Box for a partner on the Entry Form. You will be placed in a "pool" and a partner/team will be selected at random for you. You may have to play in a younger age category or at a more difficult skill level. Pooling is NOT allowed in the following

sports: Baseball, Basketball (5x5), Bench Press, Flag Football, Ice Hockey, Soccer, Softball (except Women's Open).

If you enter the pool in Triathlon Team, T.C.A. Team, or a Medley Relay in Swimming, specify your specialty on your Entry Form (i.e. "cycling" for Triathlon; or "pull-up/shot-put" for T.C.A.).

**WEIGHT SPORTS:** Select the event code for the WEIGHT CLASS at which you expect to compete. You will attempt to make weight; however, you will compete at your actual weight at weigh-in, or a heavier weight class.

## GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE ASSUMPTION OF RISK OF INJURY

In consideration for being granted permission to participate in the 2010 Western States Police and Fire Games, hosted by the Northern Nevada Police & Fire Games in and around Reno/Sparks/Tahoe, Nevada, during July 2010, the undersigned, on behalf of her/himself, and all heirs, successors, executors, administrators, next of kin and assigns (collectively "successors"), hereby fully release, discharge and hold harmless each and all Cities, Counties, Departments, Agencies, Corporations, Associations, their members, directors, agents, employees, associates and staff, and all others involved in any way in the aforesaid 2010 Western States Police and Fire Games, from any and all claims, loss, damage and liabilities which said undersigned and/or any successors may now have or which may accrue against any of the aforementioned entities or persons by reason of the undersigned's voluntary participation in any of the activities and events relating to the 2010 Western States Police and Fire Games.

The undersigned by participation, freely and voluntarily, expressly and impliedly, assumes the risk of death or any type of injury (including physical or emotional) (s)he may sustain; including medical and hospital expenses, permanent or partial disability, death and/or damage to any property. The undersigned voluntarily waives any right(s) to any remedy against those released hereunder (s)he may have as a result of injury.

The undersigned further agrees that prior to participating, (s)he will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and acknowledges hereby that (s)he understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from the actions or inactions of the participant, but also from the intentional or negligent acts of others, including but not limited to participating Cities, Counties, Departments, Agencies, Corporations or Associations, their members, directors, agents, employees, associates and staff, from the rules of play and their application, from the conditions of the premises and/or equipment, and from other causes now unknown or not now reasonably foreseeable.

The undersigned warrants that (s)he is in good health and has no physical condition preventing participation.

The undersigned acknowledges that (s)he executes this "General Release of Liability and Acknowledgement of Assumption of Risk of Injury" freely and voluntarily, and that (s)he does not rely on any inducements, promises or representations made by the aforementioned organizations, entities or individuals involved in the 2010 Western States Police and Fire Games, or of any person associated in any way therewith, and intend by signing, to execute a complete and unconditional release of liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.

# TEAM INSTRUCTIONS

**ADMINISTRATIVE FEE:** On-Line Entry at [www.cpfaf.org](http://www.cpfaf.org) or at [www.wspfg2010.org](http://www.wspfg2010.org) is strongly encouraged. PAPER Entry Forms will be charged a \$10 Administrative Fee. **Team Captains who collect and submit team members paper entries together will be charged only one time (i.e., \$10 for the team); to be included on the captain's entry form.**

A Team event is any event having 3 or more entrants competing together against a mutual opponent. A Team must have ONE named Team Captain.

**Only Team Captains are responsible for submitting Team Rosters with their entry form.** Changes to team make-up are possible. In case of such changes, a "Final Roster" shall be submitted at the Team Captain's Meeting, or as otherwise instructed, prior to the beginning of competition.

Each team shall have a **Team Name** for scheduling purposes. The Team Name shall be provided on the Team Roster. Teams will be identified by: a) Team Name, b) Department and c) Team Captain.

**Team Captains for combined agency teams are reminded that they must include all team members' names and their agency affiliations on the Team Roster.**

**TEAM MEMBERS:** Each TEAM MEMBER shall complete an individual entry form, on which is listed the LAST NAME and FIRST NAME of the Team Captain.

**Bench Press, Biathlon, Cross Country, Golf, Pistol Events, Rifle-Large Bore, Rifle-Small Bore, Road Race, Skeet, Sporting Clays, Trap:** All competitors, even those who only want to participate in the Team events, **MUST ENTER THE INDIVIDUAL EVENT.**

**Captains/Coaches, please be advised that all entries, changes or substitutions MUST be completed prior to the start of competition in that sport, not necessarily the start of your first game or match. All team members listed on the Final Roster MUST be entered (have submitted an entry form) in that particular event prior to the start of any competition within that specific event.**

**MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TEAM MEMBERS ALLOWED ARE LISTED UNDER EACH APPLICABLE SPORT SECTION:** Please refer to this information when completing the Roster.

## **NON-PLAYING COACHES:**

**A COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND SIGNED RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM IS REQUIRED FOR ALL NON-PLAYING COACHES OR MANAGERS. PLEASE SUBMIT PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT REGISTRATION.**

Non-Playing Coaches and Managers, who are not team members (no entry fees), are not eligible to receive WSPFGF medals. Exceptions: in Baseball, Basketball, Flag Football, Ice Hockey, Paintball, Softball and Soccer teams can add a Non-Playing Coach who may receive a medal provided they meet the same requirements as all other entrants (be a law enforcement officer or firefighter from an eligible agency & pay entry fees).
